- Ensure your iPad is ready to be setup by completing the [New iPad Checklist](#)

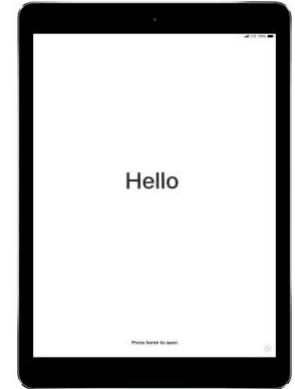
# Purchasing an iPad for your child

1. Purchase an iPad and related accessories from the [GHPS iPad Portal](#) (opening soon) at competitive prices (see QR code)
2. Purchase an iPad and related accessories from your **preferred supplier**
3. Use an **existing device** and accessories provided it is no more than four years old and can run the latest version of iOS (we do not recommend using the iPad Mini)



# Setting up your child's iPad

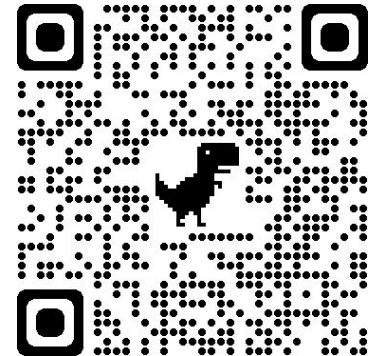
- Devices need to be brought in week 1 of 2025. You will need to:
  - *Deliver the iPad to school ready to be set up as a new device. This means you have not turned it on and gone through the setup process.*
  - *If your iPad is currently set up and in use, please back up your data, sign out of all Apple accounts and reset the device to factory settings.*

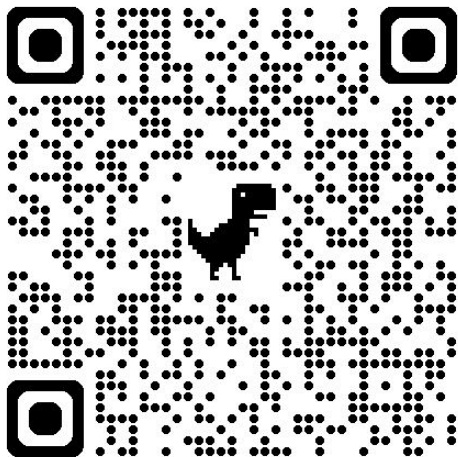
# Setting up your child's iPad

- An Apple ID is ***not required*** to run the iPad on the school network. You may, however, add one once it is set up.
- When creating an Apple ID for your child, we strongly suggest you use ***Family Sharing*** for safety and security purposes.
